This approach fosters a strong competition for all skill levels and enables players to progress at their own pace while enjoying the sport.

#### **Competition Structure**

The SCNA Divisional competition caters to players aged 11 to 18 years, with teams being graded based on skill level rather than age.

This inclusive approach allows for a diverse mix of ages within teams, creating a competitive environment for all participants. The fixtures are scheduled to be played every Saturday from March to September, with games starting at various times throughout the day.

The age groups for the competition are as follows:

- 5-7 Years: Net Set Go Blue
- Turning 8 Years: Net Set Go Green
- Turning 9 Years: Net Set Go Gold
- Turning 10 Years: Net Set Go White
- Turning 11 Years to 18 Years: Still School Age Divisional from 1 (Top) through 17
